

ACADEMIC CREDIT FOR THE BEST PRACTICES SCHOOL THROUGH JOHNSON STATE COLLEGE

Through a collaborative effort, academic undergraduate and graduate credit for the 2009 Best Practices School is available from **Johnson State College** for an additional cost.

If you are currently enrolled in an academic program, or are thinking of enrolling in a particular program, it is very important that you check with your faculty advisor or institution to ensure that these credits will transfer into your program and count toward your degree.

In addition, some academic programs have approved the Best Practices School for undergraduate or graduate credit as an independent study for students enrolled in their institutions. Check with your faculty advisor.

Colleges and Universities Offering Academic Credit:

Johnson State College, Johnson, VT - Students have the opportunity to earn undergraduate or graduate credits (3 credits for attending and some additional follow up work). The cost is \$200 per credit hour, which is paid directly to Johnson State College. Interested participants will be able to sign up to receive additional materials at the school.
