Last year nearly 600 participants attended this event, and this year we are expecting over 600 participants and faculty. Exhibiting at the school will provide an opportunity to increase the visibility and public awareness of your programs, and expand the scope of resources for our audience as well. Although the exhibit time will be limited, the exhibit hall will be on the way to the registration area through which 600 participants must pass, so there will be maximum exposure for a minimum outlay of your time and effort.

The undersigned agrees to reserve exhibitor space and pay all applicable fees for exhibitor space and equipment, at the *39th Annual New England School of Addiction Studies* on June 9, 2008 .
